Receive an annual flu shot with the most ideal months being SEPTEMBER and OCTOBER

BREAST CANCER UNCONTROLLABLE RISK FACTORS



AGING: risk of breast cancer increases with age with most diagnoses found in women 55+



FAMILY HISTORY: a first-degree female relative (sister, mother, daughter) diagnoses doubles your risk



MENOPAUSE: women who go through menopause after age 55



PERSONAL HISTORY: a previous breast cancer diagnosis, makes you 3-4 times more likely to develop a new cancer in the other breast or a different part of the same breast



MENSTRUAL CYCLE: women who started menstruating younger than age 12

From January through June 2020, breast cancer was the MOST diagnosed form of cancer in females

Female breast cancer is the 4TH HIGHEST cause of cancer death in the state

Only 68% of women age 45+ were up-to-date on their mammograms in 2018, 32% were not
